ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSES

Studying Italian at Accademia Italiana allows not only to learn the Italian language but also to experience Italian culture in historical Italian destinations. General Italian Courses run all year round with a program divided into 6 levels, according to the CEFR Common European Framework, from absolute beginners to advanced level (A1-C2). All the courses develop practical communication skills. The minimum age for students is 16 in Salerno and 18 in Napoli and Roma.

STANDARD

4 group lessons a day, 20 lessons per week

INTENSIVE

6 group lessons a day, 30 lessons per week

This course is recognised as *Bildungsurlaub* in Germany.

SUPER INTENSIVE

4 group lessons + 1 individual lesson a day, 20 +5 lessons per week

INDIVIDUAL

These courses are suitable for those who wish to reach high level results in a short time by means of a personalised program both in terms of time and method. The program is planned around the student's needs.

Minimum attendance: 2 lessons a day / 10 lessons per week

EXAMINATION COURSES

Accademia Italiana is an Authorised Examination Centre of the University for Foreigners of Siena and Perugia for CILS and CELI official certifications, recognized by the Council of Europe and for the AIL certification. The school organizes preparation courses for all these certificates. The exams take place at the school in different sessions throughout the year. Preparation courses are usually individual in order to fulfill students' needs.

Individual: 2 weeks

4 individual lessons a day / 20 lessons per week





TEACHING METHOD



The teaching method is based on the most modern techniques of teaching Italian as a second language and it develops the 4 practical skills: listening, reading, writing and speaking. Our method uses linguistic practice aided by modern text books, and multimedia material.

The small number of participants in each group (maximum 12) allows teachers to keep a constant personal relationship with students and to check their progress. All the teachers are highly qualified and specialized in teaching Italian L2/FL and with the school staff are the main point of reference of the students.

LEVELS

Italian courses run all year round with a program divided into 6 levels, according to the Common European Framework, from absolute beginners to advanced level (A1-C2). A placement test is given to students on the arrival to assess what level is right for their needs. Regular tests are given throughout the course to assess how students are progressing.

CLASSES AND CERTIFICATES

The classes are made up of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 12 students, therefore creating a group environment in which the teacher can follow the linguistic progress of each individual student. At the end of the course, students receive a certificate which states level, program and results.





COURSES FOR TEACHERS

Accademia Italiana organizes Courses for teachers of Italian L2/FL which aim to provide teachers with new didactic techniques, new skills and to give the participants greater confidence in their own Italian in order to work more effectively in Italian classes. These courses run all year round according to teachers' needs, with the possibility of choosing personalized solutions. The theoretical-practical courses give the opportunity of improving the understanding of the theoretical aspects of teaching Italian as FL/SL. Furthermore, the direct teacher training in classes, the interaction with students and colleagues from all over the world make this a rich experience for all the Teachers of Italian. DITALS I PREPARATION

FOR NON-NATIVE SPEAKERS OF ITALIAN

The DITALS is an official certification released by the University of Siena for Foreigners which aims to certify the theoretical and practical preparation of teachers of Italian L2/FL.

ACCADEMIA ITALIANA IS AN AUTHORISED TRAINING AND EXAMINATION CENTRE FOR DITALS

1 WEEK COURSE: 30 hours of theoretical and practical course for DITALS I.
Minimum level of Italian: C1 (proved by an official certification).

Native Italian Teachers can also apply for this course.

Teaching Training (EXAM prerequisite) is provided on request at extra cost.





COURSES FOR PROFESSIONALS AND INTERNSHIP

PROFESSIONALS

These courses are tailor made for professional people who need to improve the Italian language for their work, developing their knowledge of general language and specialized language of their business field. Tailor-Made **INDIVIDUAL** (one-to-one) or **SEMI-INDIVIDUAL** (2/3/4-to-1) LESSONS are offered with a personalized didactic program held by high qualified Italian teachers trained in all business fields: trading, administration, law, medicine, banking, diplomacy, HR, military, airline, etc.

Individual (1-to-1)

Semi-individual lessons (2/3/4-to-1)

4-6 lessons a day / 20 or 30 lessons per week

Minimum 1 week

Attendance: from Monday to Friday

Lesson hour: 45 minutes



INTERNSHIP

This program is challenging unpaid work experience to improve the Italian used at work. Students can practice Italian in real-life situations, participating in business activities and working in companies or for individual professionals.

with accurately selected Italian companies and professionals





ITALIAN CULTURE AND ART COURSES

These courses are combined with General Language Courses and are offered throughout the year. They have a minimum length of 1 week and are held in collaboration with local providers, Conservatories of Music, Fashion and Cooking Academies.

LITERATURE

Various programs are scheduled covering the most important periods of Italian literature, from its origins to modern times, dealing with the most important classical and modern prose and poetry writers: Dante Alighieri, A. Manzoni, S. Quasimodo, E. Montale, A. Barricco.

HISTORY OF ART

This course presents a wide view of the most important periods of Italian art, dealing with the most significant works and artists. Particular attention is given to the regional history of art from the origins of the Magna Grecia era up to the modern period.

HISTORY OF CINEMA

This course presents a complete panorama of the history of Italian cinema by means of an analysis of the most important classic film writers, such as De Sica, Fellini, Pasolini, and contemporary ones such as Tornatore, Salvatores, Scola, Bertolucci and Moretti.

HISTORY OF THEATRE

This course presents a view of the history of Italian Theatre by means of an analysis of the most important classic and modern authors: Carlo Goldoni, Luigi Pirandello, E. De Filippo, Dario Fo.



ITALIAN OPERA & MUSIC

Accademia Italiana offers different courses on Italian Opera, Singing and Musical Instruments. Students can study the most famous Italian opera libretti or they can enroll in singing lessons taught by a professional singer. Students also have the option to improve or specialize in playing a musical instrument of their choice. They can enroll in either these courses no matter their experience level. These courses can also be held in collaboration with local Conservatories of Music.

ITALIAN COOKING

This course is perfect for those who wish to learn the secrets of Italian cooking with a particular emphasis on the Campania region specialities. The lessons are taught by an expert chef who teaches students how to prepare and complete dishes: pasta, meat and vegetables dishes, pizza and desserts.

Courses are offered in collaboration with professional culinary schools.



ITALIAN PHOTOGRAPHY

This course is held by a professional photographer and consists of practical and theoretical lessons in the classroom and outside.



ITALIAN CERAMICS AND DECORATION

Accademia Italiana offers courses in the art and decoration of ceramics. Lessons are held in a typical local crafts laboratory by professional craftsmen who specialise in showing the antique methods of creating objects.



ITALIAN FASHION & DESIGN

Accademia Italiana offers different kinds of Fashion & Design Courses in collaboration with professional Accademies of Fashion and Design.

These courses provide students with the essential knowledge and skills needed to explore the world of Italian fashion and design.

Combining theoretical learning with practical experience, they offer a creative and engaging introduction to the fundamentals of the industry.





SPECIAL PROGRAMS

50 PLUS

This program is designed for seniors who want to experience Italian language and culture together with other students of a similar age.

The Program includes:

- 1 special visit with final tasting of traditional food
- 1 practical class on traditional cooking

LANGUAGE, FOOD AND WINE

This program is designed for people who want to learn Italian experiencing the local culture, cooking, food and Italian wines.

The Program includes:

- 2 weeks / 40 group language lessons (4 lessons a day)
- 2 practical classes on traditional cooking
- 2 practical classes of wine tasting
- 1 half-day city tour
- 1 special visit with final tasting of traditional food
- 1 full day excursion
- 2 seminars on wines and gastronomy

Attendance: from Monday to Friday

Lesson hour: 45 minutes



JUNIORS (AGED 14 -17) IN SALERNO

This residential program offers the possibility of learning Italian in Salerno by seaside with an intensive program which combines the study of the Italian language with a holiday in a beautiful area rich in art and history, near to the Amalfi Coast.

The Program includes:

- Italian Course: 2 weeks /40 group lessons
- Accommodation: 2 weeks/13 nights in Residence with full board
- Activities and Excursions
- Sport
- Entertainment



ITALIAN TOUR

This 3-week immersive program takes students on a cultural journey through Salerno, Napoli and Roma, with one week in each city. The program combines Italian language lessons with a rich cultural itinerary, including guided city tours, cultural activities, and authentic local experiences thus providing the perfect balance of language learning, exploration, and immersion in local traditions.

The program includes:

- 3 weeks / 60 group lessons
- N. 3 city tours
- N. 3 half-day excursions
- N. 2 full day excursions
- N. 2 practical cooking classes or traditional craft workshops
- N. 3 cultural seminars
- N. 1 Authentic food tasting experience.

FAMILIES

The Family Program is designed for parents with children (aged 7-16) who want to combine a holiday in Italy with the study of the Italian language while experiencing the culture of the South. The program includes Italian lessons and a wide range of cultural activities or language learning games.

The Program includes:

- Parents Course: 1 week / 20 group lessons
- Children Course: 1 week / 20 group lessons

SEMINARS ON THE ITALIAN CULTURE

Accademia Italiana offers a rich and varied leisure program designed to complement the language learning experience. One of our main goals is to provide students with a welcoming meeting point where they can relax, socialize, and enjoy a friendly international atmosphere. Our staff and teachers organize daily social, cultural, and recreational activities, creating opportunities for students to practice Italian while discovering local traditions and making new friends. A selection of cultural and social activities is included in the language course, while excursions, special tastings, and additional experiences are available at an extra cost. On the first day of the course, students receive complete information about the city, the school facilities, and the activities available during their stay.

SEMINARS ON THE ITALIAN CULTURE

Accademia Italiana regularly schedules weekly cultural seminars on different topics: cinema, theatre, political, music, Italian gestures, sayings and idioms, and many more. These seminars are included in the cost of the course.



MUSIC, CINEMA AND THEATRE EVENTS

Accademia Italiana organizes special evenings to attend theatre, cinema, classical and modern musical events.



SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

A variety of cultural and social activities are organized throughout the year, including seminars, museum visits, guided tours, Italian aperitif experiences, and other local events. These activities give students the opportunity to discover Italian culture, practice the language in real-life situations, and spend time with teachers and friends in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere.

CITY TOURS

Accademia Italiana regularly organizes guided city tours in Salerno, Napoli and Roma allowing students to discover ancient neighbourhoods, monuments, churches, museums, artisan workshops, and local markets. Before each visit, teachers provide introductory seminars on the history, culture, and traditions of the places students will explore, helping them better understand and appreciate Italy's rich historical heritage.





EXCURSIONS AND SPECIAL VISITS

EXCURSIONS

Accademia Italiana offers the opportunity to discover some of the most fascinating destinations in Italy, combining language learning with unforgettable cultural experiences. Each city is surrounded by remarkable historical sites, breathtaking landscapes, and unique architectural treasures that reflect Italy's rich heritage. During their stay, students can participate in engaging excursions organized by the school, designed to explore local traditions, history, art, and natural beauty.

Coastal and seaside excursions: From Salerno and Napoli students can visit some of the most renowned destinations along the Italian coast, including the Amalfi Coast with Amalfi, Ravello, and Positano and the islands of Capri and Ischia.

History and archaeology:

From the ancient ruins of Campania, with extraordinary archaeological sites such as Pompeii and Paestum, to the artistic treasures and historical landmarks of Rome, each excursion is designed to enrich students' understanding of Italian culture, history, and heritage.

SPECIAL VISITS

Accademia Italiana organizes special guided visits of small groups to local factories, following final tasting of typical products. These visits take place in the afternoon all year round. Visits generally last 2 hours each.

Visit to Olive Oil and Wine Houses

Participants visit local wines and olive oil factories with a final tasting, enjoying local handmade products like typical bruschetta and cheese.



Visit to Lemoncello Factory

Limoncello is the Amalfi Coast's pride and joy and the students of Accademia Italiana have the opportunity to tour a local limoncello factory to see how the lemons are harvested and produced into the famous yellow liqueur. At the end of the tour students have the opportunity to taste various flavors of this famous liqueur.



Visit to Mozzarella Factory

The original mozzarella is traditionally made in the Campania region of Italy from the milk of water buffalos. Students of Accademia Italiana have the opportunity to see how the original buffalo mozzarella is made in Italy and will get a chance to taste this fresh product.





ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation in Salerno, Napoli and Roma includes different options: shared and independent apartments, studio, host families (in Salerno) hotels and B&B. All our accommodation options are located in central and well-connected areas, allowing students to easily reach the school, explore the city, and fully enjoy their Italian experience.

Lodgings are available to students from the Sunday before the beginning of the course (from 12.00) until the Saturday (10.00) after the course. (Extra days must be requested at the moment of enrollment). Accommodation includes: sleeping facilities, required meals, bed linen and blankets, water, gas and electricity consumption.

TRANSFER SERVICE

This service must be booked at the time of enrolment in the Italian course. Students are required to provide their arrival details, including the date, time, and flight or train number, at least one week in advance.
